

Artesian Ice



Perfectly Protected Natural Spring Water

- Located near the city of Nelson, on the southern slopes of Copper Mountain, in the Selkirk mountains of British Columbia, <http://www.city.nelson.bc.ca/>
- A true Artesian source, protected over 580 feet under ground and capable of delivering over 50 gallons per minute.

What is an Artesian Well?

A deep drilled well through which water is forced upward under pressure. The water in an artesian well flows from an aquifer, which is under a layer of porous rock or sediment, in this case it is granite. Granite is the finest filter as it is very dense and does not dissolve into the water like softer stone. The geologic conditions necessary for an artesian well are an inclined aquifer sandwiched between rock layers. The water held in these spaces is under pressure because of the weight of water in the portion of the aquifer above it. If a well is drilled from the land surface through the overlying impervious layer into the aquifer, this pressure will cause the water to rise in the well. In areas where the slope of the aquifer is great enough, pressure will drive the water above ground level in a spectacular, permanent fountain. This Artesian well is producing over 50 gallons per minute and is capable of more with a pumping system.

More details about the well:

- The Artesian Ice Spring water comes out of the ground with a very desirable mineral balance and minimal treatment is necessary. The balance is similar and often better than world leading brands.

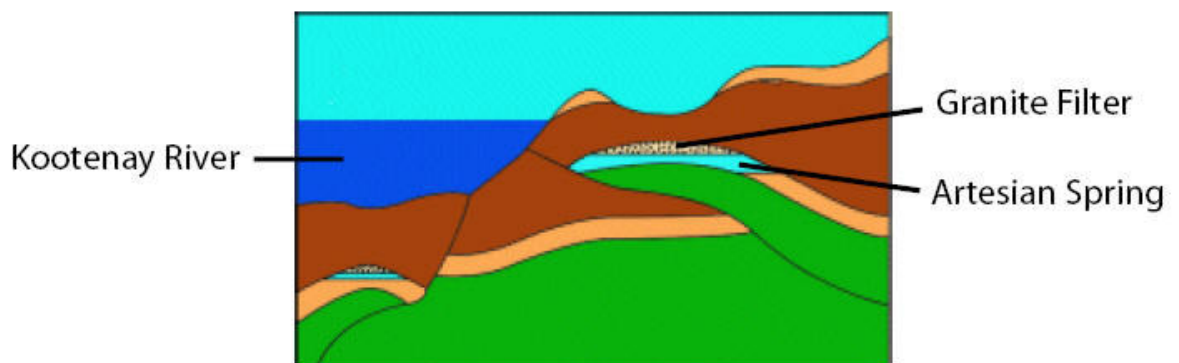
TDS 280mg/L

- Water is bottled at the source with no transportation or handling in between
- The “catchment area” is completely wooded and protected from industry, commercial properties or residential districts. The terrain above the well is too steep for development. The source is completely protected from surface contamination.
- The well is drilled through granite to a depth of 560 feet. There is a 20 foot steel pipe which reaches down to the granite... once inside the granite there is no piping.
- The steel pipe reaches right into the Plant.

Plant, Infrastructure and equipment

- The plant is a new building of 5000 Sq. ft. with a filling area, a storage and warehousing area and office spaces, with board room and lounge.
- There are two filling lines. The first line is for 5 gallon bottles, with a capacity of 120 bottles per hour with conveyor.
- The second line is for the 500ml, 1ltr, 1.5ltr. and 2ltr. Bottles. Equipment is new from 2003
- TRI Block – rinser, filler, capper, conveyors, turn table, labeling machine, shrink wrapper.
- Raw water tank – 1,300 Gallon
- Stainless steel product tank on stand – 250 Gallon
- Water treatment system
- Forklift, truck, delivery van
- Office equipment and telephone system
- Tools
